LENTEN REGULATIONS

Traditionally in the Catholic Church, the Lenten season is a
time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments,
charity and almsgiving.

The following are various Lenten regulations:

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday—These are days of

Fast & Abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on
these days for everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive.

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence
from Meat.** All who are 14 and older are bound to abstain
totally from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast.
However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something
difficult) are recommended.

Prayer to St. Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church

O glorious Saint Joseph
you were chosen by God to be
the foster-father of Jesus, the
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary,
and head of the Holy Family.
You have been chosen by Christ's
Vicar as the Heavenly Patron and
Protector of the Church founded
by Christ. Therefore, with the
greatest confidence, we implore
your powerful intercession for
the whole Church today.

Guide in a special manner,
our Holy Father and all bishops,
priests, deacons, and all members
of the Body of Christ who try
to live the Gospel message.
Be our Protector amid the trials and
tribulations of this life. Obtain
for us great purity of heart and a
fervent love for the spiritual life.

Grant that, after your example,
all our actions may be directed to the
greater glory of God, in union with
the Sacred Heart of Jesus
the Immaculate Heart of Mary,
and your own paternal heart.
Finally, pray for us that we may
share in the peace and joy of your
holy death, in the company of
Jesus and Mary. Amen.
